Just as our car passed them my eyes met with those of Marlou. She stopped her dance and the melody ceased. I wanted to roll down the window and yell, "No, no, no! Don't stop dancing! Don't stop singing! To see you dance and sing is my joy! Don't be afraid, be the child that you are. Never stop being so free, so full of life. Don't let these eyes take away your freedom. Never!"


